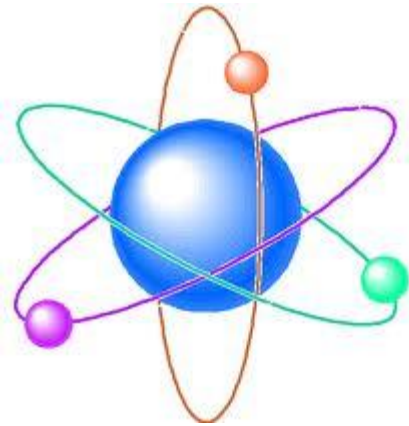
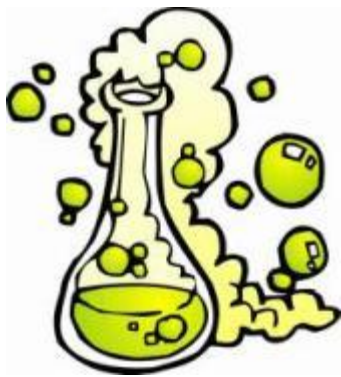

Fees and Scheduling

New Enrollees:

Registration: \$150.00

Tuition:

- Full-Time: \$1,136.00 per month
- 3-days per week: \$855.00 per month
- 2-days per week: \$604.00 per month
- Extended Day: \$1,053.00 per month
- Half Day: \$899.00 per month



Summer Activity Fees: Activity Fees cover Camper Kit (backpack, t-shirt, and water bottle), Summer Art Supplies, and Special Guests/Visitors

- **Full-Time Student Activity Fees:** \$50.00 per month
- **Part-Time Student Activity Fees:** \$25.00 per month.

Currently Enrolled Students:

Tuition: Tuition will remain the same as it does throughout the 2012-2013 school year based on your child's current program (see rates above).

Summer Activity Fees: Activity Fees cover Camper Kit (backpack, t-shirt, and water bottle), Summer Art Supplies, and Special Guests/Visitors

- **Full-Time Student Activity Fees:** \$50.00 per month
- **Part-Time Student Activity Fees:** \$25.00 per month.

Registration: Parents will still need to fill out a registration form in order to reserve a space for summer. Parents can indicate on the form if they will be:

- Remaining in their current program (ensuring their space will be reserved for the 2012-2013 school year)
- Adjusting their current program (if families are planning on increasing/reducing their child's schedule)
- Disenrolling their child from the program for the summer months**

****Parents who disenroll their children during the summer months who are planning on returning for the 2013-2014 school year are not guaranteed their previous space in the classroom, as we are a year-round enrollment school. If parents are planning on disenrolling their children at any point during the summer, a 30-day written notice is still needed.**
