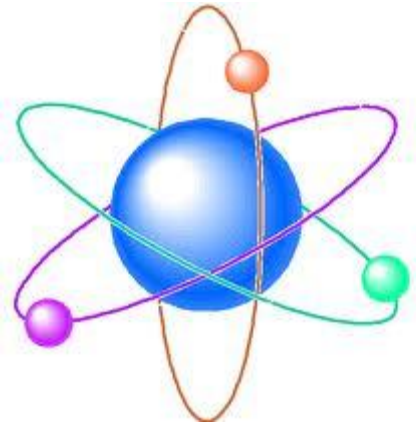
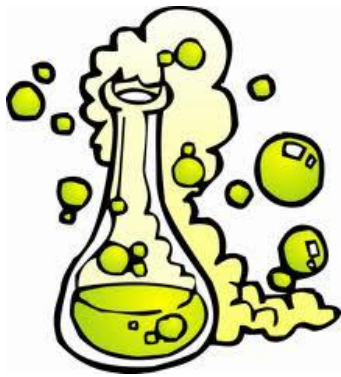

Registration: \$150.00

Tuition: Tuition for School Age Campers is **\$250 per week**. Parents will need to indicate on the registration form which weeks their child will be attending.

Payments and Billing: Payment is due by the 25th of the prior month. We will bill monthly for every week your child is scheduled to attend. If payment is not received by the 1st of each month, your child cannot attend camp until payment is received in full.

ACH Payments: Parents who wish to pay using our ACH Easypay Automated Draft will need to fill out an authorization form prior to enrollment. Payments made through our ACH Easypay method will be drafted from bank accounts on the 25th of the prior month. Please ask a member of the administration team for an authorization form if you elect to pay using this method.
